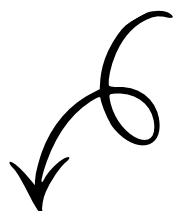

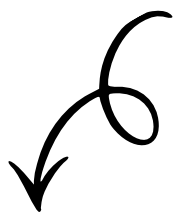
Coins & Jewels

Clear Hair Gel

Squeeze Paint

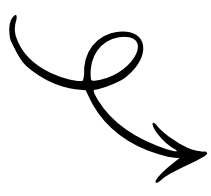
Quart Bag

Tape



Directions

- Fill the quart bag about half full with hair gel
- Squeeze in a few drops of green paint
- Add coins & jewels
- Close and tape the top
- Allow your child to squish the gel and mix the paint to turn it green
 - Slide the coins, make patterns, shapes, or letters in the gel, describe the feeling of it or the action words

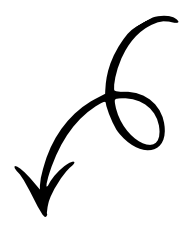

Construction Paper

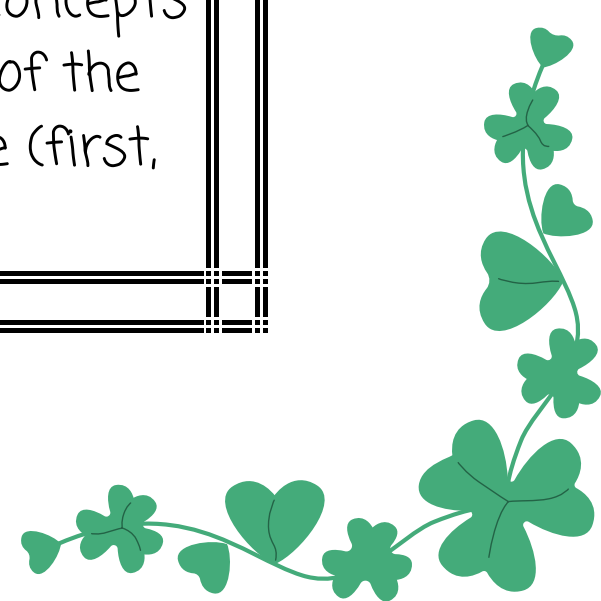
White Craft Poms

Glue Sticks



Directions

- Cut curved pieces of rainbow colors, making each subsequent curve a little smaller
- Glue them to make a rainbow
- Glue bundles of white poms at the bottom of the rainbow to make clouds
- Talk about the colors of the rainbow, size concepts (big, medium, little), describe the feeling of the poms and the glue, describe the sequence (first, next, then)

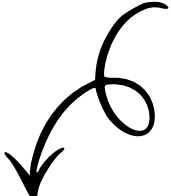
